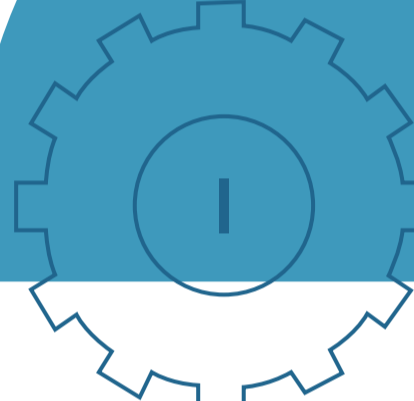

ABOUT SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY WATER TECHNOLOGY CLUSTER

The San Joaquin Valley Water Technology Cluster was formed as a collaborative effort between California State University, Fresno, and approximately 30 manufacturers of water technology and related equipment.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The summer internship program is designed to give students exposure to their chosen occupations in the manufacturing industry. This special training program for students interested in manufacturing-related positions has been developed by the San Joaquin Valley Water Technology Cluster in collaboration with Fresno City College and Reedley College.

FEATURES |

- > INTERNSHIPS WILL LAST 2-4 MONTHS DURING THE SUMMER.
- > DURING THE INTERNSHIP, STUDENTS ARE PAID \$8.50 PER HOUR FOR A MINIMUM OF 150 HOURS.
- > SUMMER INTERNS WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE WATER TECHNOLOGY TRAINING ACADEMY WHICH INCLUDES A SERIES OF HALF-DAY WORKSHOPS ON TOPICS IMPORTANT TO THE INDUSTRY. THE COURSES HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS WORKPLACE SAFETY, MANUFACTURING FLOW PROCESS, BASIC SHOP MATH, TEAMWORK, DIVERSITY, AND BASIC EMPLOYMENT SKILLS.

- > ON-THE-JOB EXPERIENCE IN MANUFACTURING-RELATED OCCUPATIONS TO INCREASE THEIR COMPETITIVENESS IN THE WORKPLACE UPON PROGRAM COMPLETION.

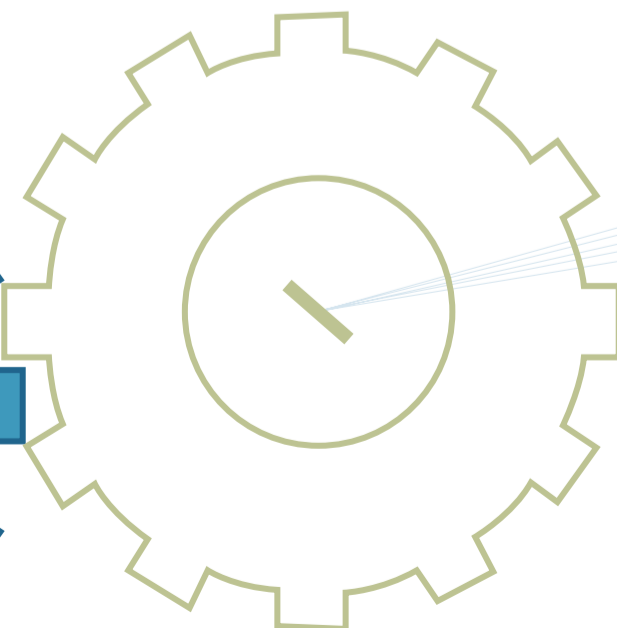
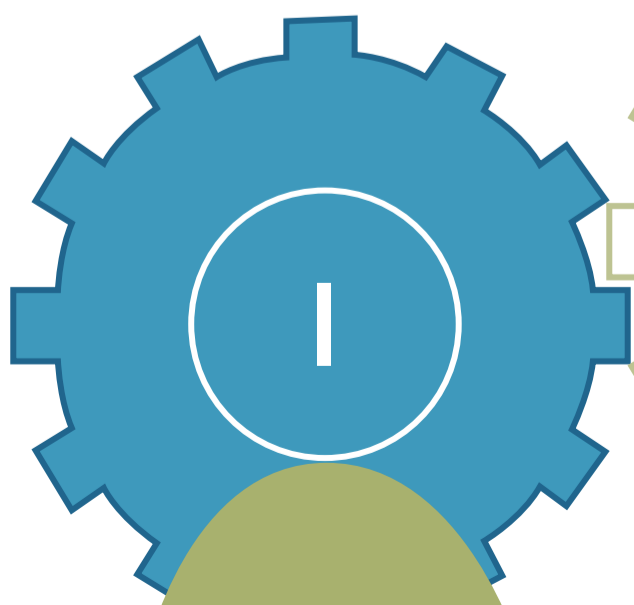
WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM

The Work Experience program is designed to provide manufacturing technology students with the benefit of part-time employment in a manufacturing environment while attending classes, thus allowing them to gain exposure to the industry.

- > PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES
- > WORK EXPERIENCE POSITIONS CAN BE IN ANY JOB WITHIN A MANUFACTURING COMPANY.
- > THE POSITIONS CAN BE ANY LENGTH OF TIME DURING THE YEAR.
- > DURING WORK EXPERIENCE, STUDENTS ARE PAID \$8.50 PER HOUR BY THE COMPANY.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

- > ENROLLED AT FRESNO CITY COLLEGE OR REEDLEY COLLEGE IN A TWO YEAR APPLIED TECHNOLOGY FIELD.
- > COMPLETE FIRST YEAR OF PROGRAM PRIOR TO STARTING INTERNSHIP PROGRAM OR BE ENROLLED IN A PARTICIPATING COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROGRAM FOR THE WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM.
- > MAINTAIN A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF AT LEAST 2.5 DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR.
- > BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE WHEN STARTING INTERNSHIP AND WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAMS.
- > BE AVAILABLE TO INTERN DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS IN THE SUMMER MONTHS.
- > PASS DRUG SCREEN REQUIREMENTS (COMPLETED UPON RECEIVING AN INTERNSHIP).
- > SUBMIT A FACULTY RECOMMENDATION FORM.
- > FULFILL REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIC TO THE HOST COMPANY.
